SECTION 1: GAME PLAY RULES

1.1 THE BASICS

It's regular NAPA 9-ball rules with the following exceptions:

- 1. 9-ball on break does not count as a win 9-ball spots immediately breaker keeps shooting.
- 2. Alternating breaks. No Rackless Match Bonus Point.
- 3. 2-ball must always be at the bottom back point in the rack.
- 4. You can't cheese the 9-ball for the win. It must be the last ball to drop in order to win.
- 5. You can, however, purposely pocket the 9-ball and keep shooting as long as you shoot the lowest numbered ball on the table first. After performing this shot, 9-ball spots immediately, and shooter keeps shooting.
- 6. Rack your own.
- 7. Players will have a completely separate CueSpeed 9-Ball Pro Rating for this format.

9-BALL OPTION

8. If, while shooting at the 9-ball, the 9-ball falls into any pocket **OTHER** than the called pocket, the opponent has the option to play the 9-ball or hand the shot back to the original shooter.
