Power Dam In House Pool Additional Rules

- 1 Players will establish their average after first night of league play. Play straight up first night.
- 2 Cue ball fouls: You may not touch the cue ball with any part of the cue. Use your hand anytime you position cue ball.
- 3 8 Ball on the break will be re-racked or spotted. See rule book.
- 4 Make up games are to be done before the next week league play. They can be play same night if played first. Averages will be checked prior to the next week's play.
- 5 Handicap maximum is 8 points per round/2 max per person. First match up round is handicap for all rounds. Both teams list players **in order from low to high average**. New players go in position 2. 2 new players go in 2 and 3. See league reps with questions.
- 6 Player info sheet must be completely filled out first week of play.
- 7 Must have three (3) players at all times. NO exceptions.
- 8 18/19/20 year olds may play in league but cannot play in any sanctioned tournament.
- 9 **No Roster Changes after Nov 15. There are no floating subs.**
- 10 When a player is absent for a match, the following procedure will be used: Absent player will receive 0 and opponent receives 10.
- 11 The end of the season party is pot luck. Contact your league representatives for information on what to bring.
- 12 Any problems should be written on scoresheet, not on or in money envelope.
- 13 **If roster is full (3reg/3sub) at least half of leagues captains' approval is needed to add a new player. One will need to be dropped from the current roster. This can be done the week before or night of PRIOR to play no later than Nov 15.**
- 14 All captains need to notify league coordinator of all changes in team players.
- 15 All captains are required to give a phone number to all other team captains.
- 16 Each team is to list a co-captain to make decisions in absence of the team captain.
- 17 Only captain OR co-captain can represent the team at meetings. Only one may attend, not both.
- 18 It is up to captains in the match to make decision if player requests to play all 4 games first. Player must have a very good reason to make this request. If granted, games must be played on the league table assigned that night. If player is found giving untruthful reason, player may never again be permitted to request to play their 4 games first again.
- 19 Eight ball rule is in effect. Scratch on 8 is ball in hand if 8 is not pocketed or knocked off table.
- 20 Team forfeits are recorded as 4 rounds won, 9 games won, and 90 points for the team. No individual stats are recorded and no credit.
- 21 **Sanction fee is \$20 (\$15 Valley/\$2 Indiana/\$3Compusport)**
- 22 If league finishes with 8 or more teams, 1st place only receives a certificate in the amount of \$150 towards OH or IN state. If 6 or 7 teams finish, 1st place only receives a certificate in the amount of \$75 towards Ohio or Indiana state tournament. If first place does not go, the certificate does not get passed down.
- 23 If there is a bye, the team who got the bye the first week figures their average that night after last game to figure handicap.
- 24 Tournament Requirements:

GREAT LAKES - 9 Weeks of play by cutoff date for Great Lakes. April 4-6, 2025
Cutoff date will be announced on the entry form.
Players may be put in any order at tournament.

APPRECIATION TOURNAMENT - (11-23-24) 4 Weeks play required for entry. Online signup Nov 1- Nov 18.

STATE VALLEY TOURNAMENTS- Ohio requires 9 weeks in one session, or 12 in two by Mar 1, 2025. Apr 24-27, 2025
Indiana requires 12 weeks played by Feb 1, 2025. Mar 12-16, 2025

BCA STATE TOURNAMENTS- All BCA State events require 4 weeks played IN ONE SESSION to qualify.

BCA VEGAS TOURNAMENT ENTRIES - Vegas requires 8 weeks played Jan1-Dec 31, 2024. Feb 19-Mar 1 2025

VNEA VEGAS TOURNAMENT ENTRIES - Vegas requires 12 weeks played by Mar 1, 2024. May 22-May 31, 2025
